The elegant five-star hotel offers 55 spacious suites and rooms and two stunning private chalets. It boasts a fantastic ski-in/ski-out location perched on the heights of Belvedere, close to Le Rond-Point des Pistes, offering panoramic views across the slopes of Méribel. The private chalets are both independent four-bedroom residences. They have their own ski room, pool and spa, offering guests the utmost privacy but still experiencing the five-star service Le Coucou offers.

There is also a strong emphasis on wellness and recovery. The on-site Tata Harper Spa offers a range of rejuvenating treatments while two swimming pools and a fitness center allow guests to stay active off of the pistes as well.
