Where to stay on your next winter wonderland holiday



Whether you're one for the ski slopes or prefer kicking back and scanning the skies for the Northern Lights, these digs will let you bask in the snowy glow in luxurious fashion.

For a chic chalet stay in the Trois Vallées ski resort of Méribel, you can't go wrong with this new opening. Designed by French interior designer Pierre Yovanovitch, the five-star ski-in, ski-out boutique resort boasts 55 guest rooms and suites done up in a contemporary alpine style. Playful pops of colour and geometric furnishings accent wood and stone materials, and most rooms come with balconies with dramatic views of the slopes. There's also an indoor and outdoor pool, gym, bar and two restaurants: Biananeve's signature is Italian cuisine (think dishes such as spaghetti al branzino and pizza with truffle sauce and arugula) while Beefbar's focus on rare cuts of steak will delight meat-lovers. There's also the Kid's Club and Teens Lab with plenty of activities to keep young ones entertained.
